



Dr Thomas Peinbauer is the President of the European Committee for Homeopathy (ECH) and former General Secretary of the Liga medicorum homoeopathica internationalis (LMHI).

He studied at the Medical University of Vienna (Austria) and the University of Valencia (Spain) with a one-year-ERASMUS-scholarship in 1992/93. After completing the hospital training as general practitioner he founded a homeopathic medical practice in Upper Austria in 2001.

He is member of both Austrian homeopathic medical organizations – Österreichische Gesellschaft für homöopathische Medizin (ÖGHM) and Ärztesellschaft für Klassische Homöopathie (ÄKH) – and co-founder of the Students Initiative for Homeopathy (SIH) at the University of Vienna. As former lecturer for homeopathy at the Medical University of Vienna he was appointed lecturer for continuing homeopathic education of ÖGHM in 2008.

Beside other publications he is co-author of the German standard work „Pfeiffer, Drescher, Hirte: Homöopathie in der Kinder- und Jugendheilkunde“ (Homeopathy in Paediatrics).

He was born on 20th of December 1969 in Austria and lives in Linz on the Danube.
